ELIGIBILITY

- Licensed RN, NP, PA, or MD with at least one year of clinical experience
- Interest in becoming a member of the Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner (SAFE) Team at Crisis Services

TRAINING DESCRIPTION

This comprehensive training offers instruction on how to care for and collect evidence from an adolescent or adult who has been sexually assaulted...

- 41 hours of online training on national standards, with CEUs
- 32 hours of classroom training on local procedures and clinical instruction

After the formalized instruction, a preceptorship follows to practice and prove competency in speculum exams and evidence collection.
